

Renal Disease in Minority Populations and Developing Nations- The Post Congress Satellite meeting of the WCN 2007

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION RULES

Your abstract should contain a brief description of the work you have undertaken and should indicate the conclusions you have reached. Display boards will be provided for poster sessions. All presentations will be posters only. You can submit more than one abstracts and are to be printed in the dimension as provided by the secretariat of the post congress satellite meeting, which will be informed to you once your abstract/s is selected for presentation. Please also note that you have an option to re-submit the abstract which you have already submitted for the main congress.

MODE OF SUBMISSION

Submission of abstract/s is only online. Please contact the congress secretariat if you encounter any difficulties during the submission of abstracts. Instructions are clearly outlined in the abstract submission page.

FORMAT

Size: The abstract should not exceed 4000 characters. A counter is provided to aid abstract/s submitters. Only selected abstracts will be considered for poster session.

Content: Please organize the abstract in the following format:

1. Introduction & Purpose of the Abstract
2. Methodology
3. Results
4. Conclusions
5. Keywords

Only standard abbreviations and generic names may be used. Place unusual abbreviations or acronyms in parentheses after first use. Do not identify author(s) or institution(s) in the text. List author(s) and institution(s) at the bottom, in the space provided.

Author(s) and Affiliation: Author(s) and affiliation should be placed at the bottom of the abstract. Include last name, first name and middle initials of the author(s). Do not include degrees or titles. UNDERLINE the presenting author. Affiliation should include only the name of the institution, city and state or country.

LANGUAGE

English is the official language of the conference and all abstracts **MUST** be submitted in **ENGLISH** only.

ABSTRACT PRESENTATION

The selected abstracts will be allowed to be presented only if one of the authors have registered as a delegate for the Renal Disease in Minority Populations and Developing Nations- the Post Congress Satellite meeting of the WCN 2007. The abstracts submitted by an author will not be allowed to be presented by another delegate unless he/she has also registered for the satellite and has sought permission earlier.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Should the abstract be chosen, any employment or contractual relationship with a pharmaceutical or equipment company, which might pose a potential, apparent, or real conflict of interest with regard to their contribution to the congress, should be disclosed.

PRODUCT NAMES

Product names should only be used if your study relates to treatment outcomes. They should not be used for promotional purposes.

A panel of experts will assess submitted abstracts.

- The Scientific Program Committee of the **Post Congress Satellite meeting of the WCN 2007** will make the final decision on acceptance or rejection of any abstract.

IMPORTANT

Authors of abstracts accepted for presentation **MUST** be responsible for all expenses incurred in the production of their presentation, travel and accommodation during the congress, unless supported by the scholarship grant ([please visit www.wcn2007postcongress.org](http://www.wcn2007postcongress.org), click at Scholarships & Awards for details of the grant).

Upon request, the secretariat may provide a letter of invitation for immigration purposes only.

All authors **MUST** sign the consent for publication of the abstract if selected for publication in a peer reviewed journal. The organizing committee will take into consideration of the consent provided by the delegate during the online abstract submission process

Check that you have:

- Included the full name and address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address of the Presenting Author
- Acknowledged the submission confirmation on the Abstract form
